What makes a great poster?

- clear message about the importance of immunization
- bright colours
- imaginative design
- words can be seen at a distance

Contest rules

- Open to Grade 6 students registered in a Canadian school in the 2010-2011 school year.
- One entry per person! No group entries.
- No computer drawings! Use crayons, markers, pencils or paint.
- Poster size must be 11"x17" (279mm x 432 mm).
- Posters must be drawn horizontal/landscape (not vertical/portrait).
- Posters must show the importance of immunization for kids' health.
- Glue the completed entry form to the back of your poster. (Don't staple or paper-clip it.)
- Mail posters flat in a big envelope (not folded or rolled).
- Children of employees of Health Canada, the Public Health Agency of Canada, and the Canadian Public Health Association are ineligible.
